- 1. The scaffold is to be used for the purpose described and must not be overloaded or the number of lifts exceeded.
- 2. The Hirer will ensure all necessary permission has been obtained from the Local Authority that any necessary Building Notices have been submitted in accordance with regulations and that we have been informed of this in writing before commencement of any works. This includes any necessary road closure.
- 3. We regretfully cannot accept responsibility for damage that may occur to cultivated areas, although every possible care will be taken.
- 4. The quotation is based on the measurements provided by the Hirer and is therefore subject to a site inspection and measurement.
- 5. The quotation is based upon the assumption that work will be within normal working hours. Any work required outside of these hours will be additionally invoiced to the hirer.
- 6. Suitable access for our delivery transportation is required, enabling the material to be offloaded and re-loaded within 10 metres of the scaffold site. If a greater distance is involved, an additional charge may be made.
- 7. All scaffolds are erected and maintained to current Health & Safety legislation standards. We are committed to ensuring we remain up to date with current legislation and will provide scaffolds built to the highest quality standards.
- 8. The Hirer will ensure the security of the scaffold at all times, preventing unauthorised access.
- 9. Please remove satellite dishes from buildings before we commence erection of the scaffold. It is your responsibility to replace it afterwards. If you do not remove it, we cannot accept responsibility for any damage.
- 10. None of our materials are fire retardant, unless specifically stated in the quotation.
- 11. The Hirer is to ensure that we are provided with a firm and level base for our scaffold that will not settle under the self-weight plus the design loads imposed. The base is to be extended at least 300mm outside the scaffold. If timbers larger than 2" scaffold boards are required, these are to be provided by the Hirers.
- 12. Single scaffold boards used as sole boards/plates have been provided for. If this is not sufficient for the ground conditions, you will be automatically invoiced.
- 13. This quotation is based upon current regulations and legislation. Should these or any working practices change, any resulting extra work or provision will be invoiced as appropriate.
- 14. The Hirer will ensure that the roof safely supports the weight of the scaffold structure plus the design imposed load. We regretfully cannot accept responsibility for damage caused by or arising from working off fragile roofs, or creating scaffold spanning roofs / conservatories although every possible care will be taken.
- 15. The Hirer is fully responsible for the protection of the roof surface and therefore any damage.
- 16. No additional items such as protective sheeting, debris netting etc. may be fixed to our scaffolding without written permission.
- 17. Off hired scaffolds are removed as soon as possible within the scheduling of the day to day business, we do not accept any responsibility for delays incurred in works during his period. (We actively encourage liaison with us to ensure the dismantle period causes minimum disruption to the Hirer).
- 18. The inclusive hire period stated in the quotation denotes the minimum length of the contract. There will be no refund for any remaining period.
- 19. There is no allowance for holidays during the hire period.
- 20. Should the hire period stated in the quotation be exceeded, the Hirer is liable for over hire charges at 5% of total scaffold costs plus VAT per week or part week, until point of off hire.
- 21. The quoted price is firm for 4 weeks, or subject to clients requirements discussed prior to quotation. This will be stated on the quote subject to acceptance within 60 days.
- 22. All prices unless otherwise stated are exclusive of VAT (if applicable at current rate) and VAT will be added on.
- 23. Payment is to be paid pro forma.
- 24.
